HISTORY OF THE FUND

In 2014, a donor from the congregation of the 1stUUPB donated funds to be used to offer scholarships to those who are choosing to enroll in either public or private colleges or trade schools. Those students who have demonstrated involvement in social justice work and can state a plan for future social justice work will receive priority.

HISTORY OF HARRIETTE GLASNER

A founding member of this congregation, Harriette Glasner was devoted to justice. After her arrival in Palm Beach County in 1952, she became a trailblazer in advocating for civil rights, women’s rights, reproductive justice and human rights.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS

- Applicants must have earned or be in the process of earning a high school diploma or GED in Palm Beach County.
- Applicants must be enrolling in a private or public college, university or trade school.
- Recipients must agree to attend the award service of the congregation in April.
- The number and dollar amount of awards may vary from year to year. Each award may be up to \$2000. Administrators of the fund will review applications and announce awards by March 31st.
