ARTICLE 13 – COMMITTEE ON MINISTRY
9-27-22 Proposed Changes

13.1 Purpose – The purpose of the Committee on Ministry shall be to help the Congregation carry on and strengthen the quality of the shared ministry. It shall function as a committee of the Congregation, not as a committee of the Board.

13.2 Composition – The committee shall consist of three (3) members, all of whom shall be Voting Members of the Congregation. Members shall serve staggered three-year terms with a limit of two (2) successive terms. At each Annual Meeting, the Congregation shall elect one (1) member for a term of three (3) years and other members necessary to fill the unexpired terms of vacant positions which had been filled temporarily.

13.3 Responsibilities – Responsibilities of the Committee on Ministry are:

13.3.1 To advise the Board and the Minister on the effectiveness of the shared ministry and to propose measures and conduct activities to sustain or improve the quality of Congregational life;

13.3.2 To provide support for right relations within the Congregation by administering the Congregation's Policy for Restoring Right Relations, as adopted and amended by the Board of Trustees;

13.3.3 In cooperation with the Board, to conduct Congregation-wide assessments of the shared ministry and periodically deliver State of the Ministry messages to the Congregation.
